

## ABOUT MARIBOR

### How to reach Maribor:

#### By Plane:

1. Nearest airport - GRAZ ( +/- 69 km)
2. Best-connected airport - Vienna ( +/- 250 km). There is a direct train from Vienna to Maribor.
3. Zagreb Airport
4. Ljubljana Airport
5. Budapest Airport

#### By train:

Maribor train station is in the eastern part of the Maribor city centre.

By train, you can travel to Maribor for example from:

1. Vienna Meidling – Maribor (3 hr 30 m)
2. Graz – Maribor (1 hr)
3. Venezia Santa Lucia – Ljubljana – Maribor (9 - 10 hr)
4. Zagreb – Dobova – Zidani most – Celje – Pragersko – Maribor (3 hr 30 min)
5. Budapest – Vienna – Graz – Maribor (6 hr 30 min)
6. Prague – Vienna – Maribor (9 hr)

You can find more connections and schedule information at Slovenian Railways.

#### By bus:

- You can get Flixbus at very reasonable prices from many European cities.

#### Going Around:

Maribor is quite a small town, so it's easy to get around the city centre on foot. There are two tourist information centres in Maribor: one at Partizanska ulica 6a, next to the Franciscan Church (the red-brick one). The other one is in the Old Vine House on Lent, the oldest part of the town next to the river embankment (at Vojašniška Ulica 8).

The Venue of the Conference is in the city centre, 2 minutes walking from the Franciscan Church.

Hotel Piramida – 80 – 100 Euros

Hotel Maribor – 110 – 160 Euros

Hotel Lent – 80 - 100 Euros

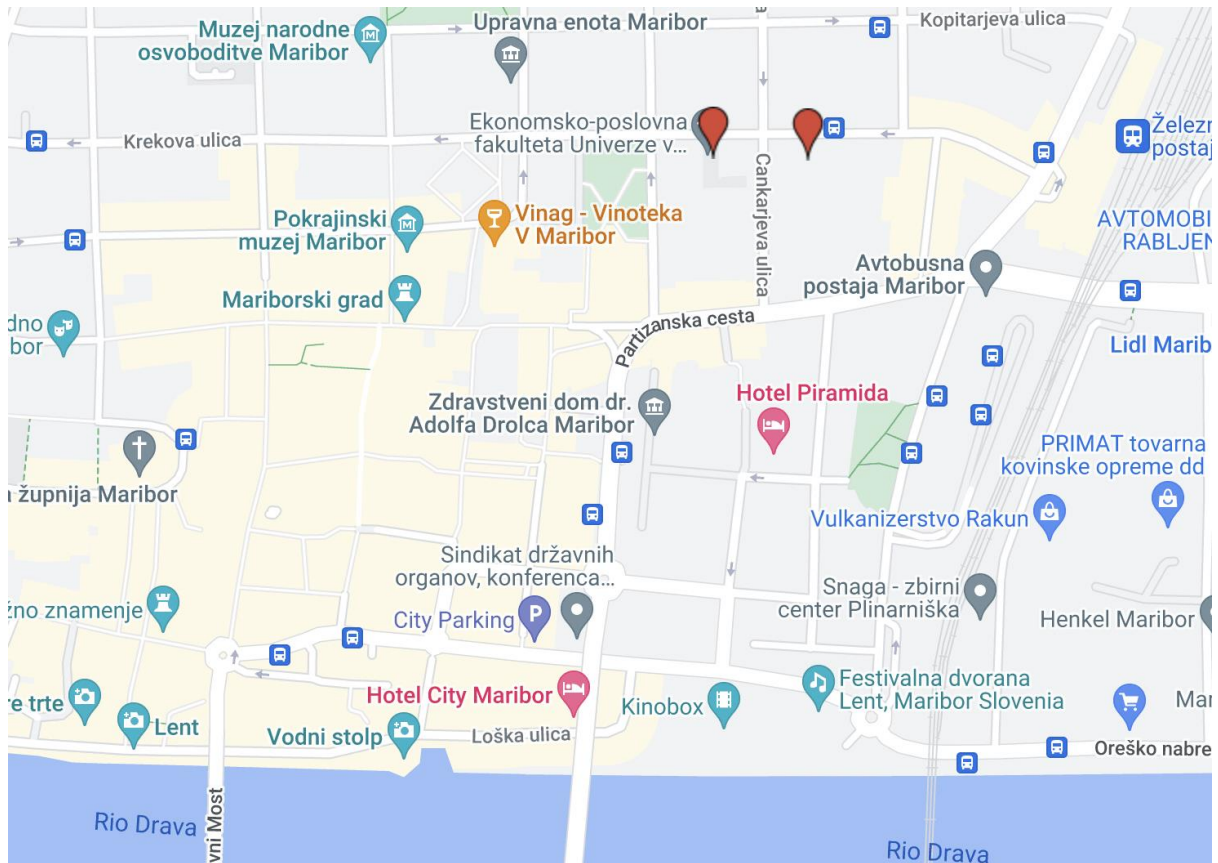
( all mentioned hotels are at walking distance from the conference Venue)
